The Open Education Latin America Regional Node (OE LATAM) is a community driven network that works cooperatively to establish, utilize and sustain a regional ecosystem that further enhances the development of open education initiatives and practices in Latin America.

Established in 2019 with the support and guidance of open education leaders from nine different countries in the region, the OELATAM is designed to serve the unique needs and challenges of their communities.

The framework fosters four main areas of collective importance:

3. Open practices
4. Infrastructure

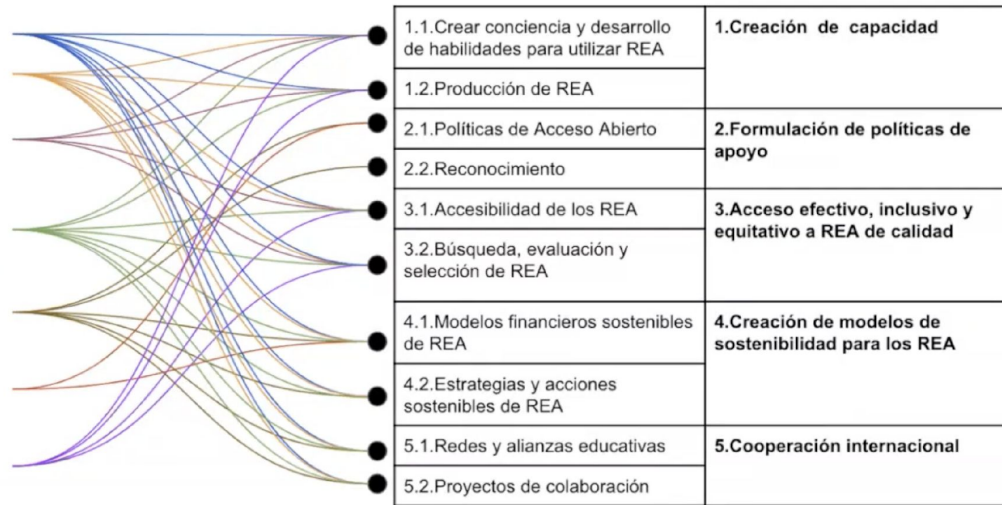
