#### Teacher in the Loop AI - COL's AI and OER initiative

- Global Digital Cooperation for Resilient Digital Environment
  - Gender, LDC, SIDS, Youth, Marginalised groups
- Pilot tested together with the University of South Pacific in Fiji, Solomon Islands and Tonga
  - Resulting in preparation of 470 lesson plans of which 100 approved as OER
- Replication in Africa and in India
  - Teachers as the nodal points to guide Al
- Peer-reviewed quality-tested educational aids as OERs
  - By teachers, but generated by GenAl
