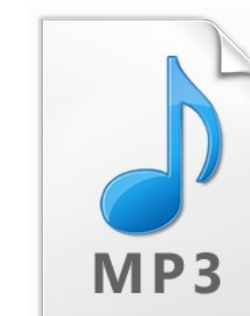
The milestone of Sumber Belajar SEAMOLEC


First phases : 2017-2020



- SEAMOLEC initiated the OER platform development within the Ministry of Education and Culture (MOEC) referring to the OER declaration (2017)
- PUSDATIN (Centre for Data and Information) and SEAMOLEC disseminated information related to the OER within the MOEC's main units as instructed by the secretary general of the MOEC to upload content on the OER Platform - (2017-2018)
- Promotion of OER platform and open content through the Indonesian Distance Learning Network (IDLN) forum – (2018)
- Provide all SEAMOLEC online MOOCs training materials in OER format –(2018)
- Provide MOOC Platform for supporting OER to Directorate of courses and training of the MOEC – (2018)
- Integrating OER Content to be used on the National MOOC platform with the standard Copyright attribute – rumahbelajar.id (2018-2020)
