

1: Legal framework

Copyright applied to software, first.

This new artifact became privatized work.

Researchers complained.

2: Principles

The GNU Manifesto lays the ground to oppose privatization.

A community forms around these principles.

Open Source Definition (26 years old).

3: Licenses

Copyleft is a hack on copyright.

Incorporating the principles, serving as the constitution of a forming community.

"OSI approved" licenses.



Protect the frontier

Al is not "programmed", we didn't know what the "preferred form in which a programmer would modify the program." OSD#2

Combat Open Washing

Actors are calling AI systems "Open Source" even though their licenses contain restrictions that go against the accepted principles of Open Source.

Informing regulators

Government regulations have begun in Europe, the United States, and elsewhere. Communities need a common understanding to educate policy makers.

Formally release a stable version.
Continue gathering global feedback, release new versions as necessary.
